Terminology used in Disclaimer

Throughout discussion and contractual terms and conditions, “We” and “Us” refers to Conwy Touring Park.

“You”, “I” and “Client” means the person who has signed the form and each and every member of the group on whose behalf the group leader has signed. If we accept a booking by telephone or by Internet, “You” or “Client” also refers to the person making the booking.

Disclaimer

Off-Road Driving can be a dangerous activity and your standard vehicle insurance will be invalid. The 4x4 circuit is a natural environment and any obstacles can be driven with appropriate training and vehicle. As a safety aid the routes will be clearly marked and designated by level of difficulty. Barriers will prevent access to unsuitable areas.

You will receive a safety briefing, a vehicle inspection and be offered professional instruction. As a duty of care we will provide basic driving instruction in the use of gears and brakes for the terrain to be tackled. Recovery when stuck is free, including safe practice advice. Under no circumstance should you attempt anything that you do not feel qualified or capable of doing in a safe and controlled way.

Site Rules

4X4 COURSE RULES

Please remember that off roading can still be dangerous, so please read and follow the rules in full to ensure you have a safe and enjoyable visit.

These rules apply to all persons using the 4x4 site on Conwy Touring Park:

1. The 4x4 course on Conwy Touring Park is open from 10.30am till 4pm. Please leave the course by closing times.
2. You must have some off road experience and be familiar with your vehicle controls before driving on the course. Please be honest on your entry form, as these events are not suitable for people with no off road experience.
3. We have a blanket speed limit of 10MPH, which must be followed.
4. All persons must wear correct fitting seatbelts, no standing in vehicles.

5. Road legal vehicles only, all documents must be shown upon entry, vehicles may be safety checked upon entry all vehicles using the site must be of safe and sound construction. The marshals and management have the right to scrutineer any vehicle, at any time and to exclude any vehicle, which is considered not to be road legal-safe for off road use.
6. ONLY people who are named on your insurance policy are permitted to drive on site – please do not allow non-experienced people to drive your vehicle off road. Please note your normal insurance may not cover you to drive off road.
7. Road legal tires only, your vehicle may have a MOT but this does not mean its road legal if tires and bodywork have been altered.
8. Drivers must not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
9. You must notify gate staff and list on entry sheet if you are taking any medication or have a specific medical condition. This info could help in the event of any emergency situation. All details will be treated in the strictest of confidence.
10. Children must be accompanied by an adult and signed in on gate by a parent or guardian, all dogs to be kept under strict control.
11. Anyone found to be speeding around the site will be removed; please respect the site rules and others using the site.
12. All drivers must have a full UK license (no kids driving)
13. Please note your normal insurance may not cover you to drive off road.
14. All routes are easy to moderate for all standard 4x4s. Your 4x4 must have a front and rear towing point. You will be advised of what routes to follow and they must be followed this depends on your vehicles capabilities. Some routes are one way please follow the signs in full this is to ensure you have a safe visit. Routes may change dependant on weather! So please check all routes.
15. You will be given upon arrival be given a map and allocated an appropriate route dependant on your vehicles capabilities see above point 14 for requirements you must stick to the routes you have been allocated.
16. IMPORTANT – If you have a winch fitted to your vehicle and are using it on site you are required to use a WINCH SAIL and a tree strop please do not attach winch cable directly to a tree, as this will cause damage! If you are not familiar with using a WINCH please don't use on site without seeking help-advice from one of the marshals who are all experienced in winch techniques. It is your duty to keep yourself safe and other around you please ensure everyone stands in a safe position well away from the winch cable.
17. Recovery – Please note if you are in need of recovery all the details of how to contact the marshals will be on back of the map you will be given, however we do have a large team of marshals on site so you will be spotted by one of them. If a marshal has advised you that they will recover you please wait patiently as they locate you and recover you.
18. Marshals will be on hand to give any help, advice – guidance or recovery on various aspects of driving or winching on the site, but any liability for any injury to person or damage to vehicles arising out of such advice or guidance is expressly excluded.
19. All contact details for first aid, marshals will be on map issued on arrival. Call the emergency number you will be given.

20. Please don't obstruct parts of the site by parking up to watch others; please park so that others may pass safely.

21. No driving on any areas that are taped off with hazard tape, there are plenty of routes laid out for your enjoyment please leave the rest to nature.

22. If you are not sure whether to drive a route get out and have a look first. The Golden Rule if in doubt DONT DO IT ! Please check all routes before driving.

23. Please respect that any decision made by the management or a marshal is final and is to be respected.

24. No refund will be offered if a customer's visit has been cut short for whatever reason.

25. If you are found to be ignoring the rules set out you will be removed from site with no refund.

26. If you need to get out of the vehicle to 'reccie' an obstacle, please be aware of other vehicles coming from behind hills and trees
